Lunch Break

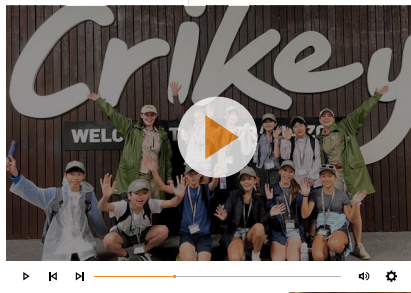
You'll have a delicious packed lunch from your homestay. You can enjoy it with friends on our sunny balcony or in the student common area.



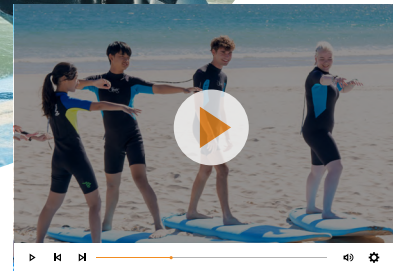
